GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Fleet Supervisor, or designee, performs manual skilled work including the layout and installation of cable & conduit, electronic equipment and supporting component installations in various equipment types. Work is reviewed through observation and results obtained.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Installation and removal of required wiring and cabling, equipment for on-car video surveillance systems, mobile radar systems, radios, LPR, computer mounting, and charge guard systems on various types of LE Vehicles and equipment;
- Performs apprentice level support of communication functions within the various facilities as required;
- Aids in keeping the shop and other working areas clean, neat, and orderly;
- Makes inspections and keeps basic records;
- May be required to operate various automotive vehicles;
- Participates in Sheriff's Office recruitment and community relations activities as directed.

QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or G.E.D
- Vocational or trade school classes in the mechanical or electrical fields preferred
- Three (3) years' experience in the installation of wiring, cabling and conduit.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Working knowledge of tools, methods, and materials in general electronics installation work
- Ability to recognize safety hazards in the work involved and takes precautionary methods to protect self and others
- Ability to receive and understand technical orders either orally or written and to communicate effectively both orally and in writing
- Ability to operate a motor vehicle
- Time management skills
- Interpersonal skills
- Ability to perform all functions of the job classification without posing a direct threat to the health or safety of other individuals in the workplace

PHYSICAL ABILITIES

The physical abilities listed below are estimates of time spent during a typical work day to perform essential functions and responsibilities. Members in this position may be required to:

- Use sufficient physical strength and agility to remove and install various radio, computer, cable, conduit etc. in vehicles and equipment where space is limited
- Visual color discrimination to match or detect differences between colors, including shades of color and brightness
- Sit up to 3 hours per day
- Walk up to 3 hours per day
- Stand up to 1 hour per day
- Drive up to 1 hour per day
- Continuously lift up to 25 lbs.
- Frequently lift up 50 lbs.
- Occasionally lift up to 100 lbs.
- Continuously bend, squat, reach, kneel, and twist
- Frequently climb
