GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the general direction of the Driving Under the Influence (DUI) Unit Sergeant, performs technical work involving the CMI Intoxilyzer 8000 instruments, completes evidentiary maintenance records and provides testimony on the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) standards for Intoxilyzer testing. Work is reviewed through observation and results obtained.

Position requires flexibility to routinely work hours during nights and weekends.
